

Longlevens Infant School Curriculum Map Year 1 Term 1

English Reading, Writing & Phonics

- Revisit Set 2 sounds from Read Write Inc.
- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words.
- Learn to read and spell 'red words' (common exception words) from the RWI books.
- Answer comprehension questions about a text.
- Use capital letters for the beginning of a sentence, names of people, places and the pronoun 'I'.
- Use full stops to punctuate sentences.
- Hold and write a dictated sentence.
- Say a sentence aloud before writing it.
- Use 'and' to join clauses in writing.
- Write parts of well-known stories.

Mathematics

- Number and place value with a focus on numbers to 20.
- Count confidently to 20, forwards and backwards.
- Represent numbers using objects, digits, pictures and on a number line.
- Read and write numbers in numerals and words.
- Identify 1 more and 1 less.
- Compare and order numbers.

Science & Technology (incl Computing)

- Identify and describe the key features of the 4 seasons.
- Observe and record the changes in weather and length of the day.
- Know how stay safe online.
- Explore technology around us.
- Explore ways we can group data.

Creative Arts & Design (Design & Technology, Art, Music)

- Use a range of drawing techniques to mark make.
- Use pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space when drawing.
- Explore the use of voices to sing and chant.
- Recognise and name percussion instruments.

- Make a moving puppet

Our World (History, Geography, RE)

- The Space Race
- Who was Neil Armstrong and why is he still remembered today?
- Who is Katherine Johnson and why is she still remembered today?
- What is the UK?
- Name the 4 countries and capital cities of the UK.
- Identify physical and human features of the UK.

Personal Development (PSHCE, PE)

- Settling in – revisit of our school rules, classroom expectations and learning powers.
- Being in my world
- Understand the rights and responsibilities of belonging to my class.
- Know my views and contributions are valued.
- Know the choices I make have consequences.
- Apply skills when participating in team games.
- Develop simple tactics.
