

Longlevens Infant School Curriculum Map Year 2 Term 1

English Reading, Writing, SPaG and Phonics

- Revisit and use sounds learnt in Year 1 in our reading and writing
- Plan what we are going to write about
- Read words in the contracted form and with possessive apostrophes
- Learn to read and spell homophones and near homophones
- Read and spell words containing Year 1 and 2 suffixes
- Write dictated sentences from memory accurately
- Make simple additions and corrections to our writing
- Read what we have written to our peers and the teacher

Mathematics

- Recognise the value of digits in 2-digit numbers
- Read and write 2-digit numbers in words and numerals
- Represent 2-digit numbers on a number line
- Compare any two 2-digit numbers using $<$ $>$ and $=$
- Identify and describe the properties of 2D and 3-D shapes including symmetry using vertical lines
- Add ones, tens and 2-digit numbers to 2-digit numbers in a range of ways
- Add three single digit numbers

Science & Technology (incl Computing)

- Know how to stay safe online
- Identify information technology around us
- Know the benefits of IT
- Know how to use IT safely
- Know how to use IT in different ways

Creative Arts & Design (Design & Technology, Art, Music)

- Explore tone and technique using different medium
- Design and make our own board games (some classes this term)
- Learn about Abstract art and use as inspiration for our own artwork (some classes this term)
- Identify and play percussion instruments
- Learn and perform Harvest songs

Our World (History, Geography)

- Know who Isambard Kingdom Brunel was and why he is remembered today
- Know how Gloucester was impacted by Brunel
- Know how Brunel has impacted our lives today
- Know the seven continents and five oceans of the world
- Identify where the SS Great Britain travelled to and what it would have been like

Personal Development (PSHE, PE)

- Recognise our emotions and be able to manage them effectively.
- Being me in my world –

 - Understand choices, rewards and consequences
